Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA): (3) offer families of students served by community learning centers opportunities for active and meaningful engagement in their children's education, including opportunities for literacy and related educational development. (2 C.F.R. 4201 (a)(3))

First and foremost ask the parents!

- Family Fitness/Nutrition
- Family Health Night: supper provided to parents and child(ren) and health presentation was given to adult family members. Speakers talked about dental, nutritional and sleep needs of children. After presentation, parents were given time to ask each specialist questions.
- Parent workshop on college readiness (FAFSA, college fair, college process, available college loans, scholarships)/college savings strategies
- Preparing your child for success: Back to school workshop
